Standard Unit Bylaws Changes June 2016

Unit Bylaws Article II. *Section 1. (Changes required to match National PTA Changes)**

The Purposes of the California State PTA, in common with those of the National PTA, are:

- a. To promote the welfare of children and youth in home, school, places of worship, and throughout the community;
- b. To raise the standards of home life;
- c. To advocate for laws that further the education, physical and mental health, welfare, and safety of children and youth;
- d. To promote the collaboration and engagement of families and educators in the education of children and youth;
- e. To engage the public in united efforts to secure the physical, mental, emotional, spiritual, and social well-being of all children and youth; and
- f. To advocate for fiscal responsibility regarding public tax dollars in public education funding.

Unit Bylaws Article V. Section 7.

Officers shall serve for a term of one (1) year or until their successors are elected. (In the event that no successor is elected, the position is declared vacant. Vacant positions must be filled by the executive board-elect or executive board, per Article V, Section 11 and Section 12). No officer shall be eligible to the same office for more than two consecutive terms or hold more than one elected or appointed office. Officers shall assume their duties on _____ [exact date, recommended to coincide with fiscal year]. No officer shall serve past the start of the next term unless elected to serve in that term. A person who has served in an office for more than six months of a full term shall be deemed to have served a full term in such office.

No officer shall be eligible to the same office for more than two consecutive terms or hold more than one elected or appointed office. Officers shall assume their duties on _____ [exact date, recommended to coincide with fiscal year]. No officer shall serve past the start of the next term unless elected to serve in that term. A person who has served in an office for more than six months of a full term shall be deemed to have served a full term in such office.

No one shall serve in the same office two (2) consecutive terms. Officers shall assume their duties on _____ [exact date, recommended to coincide with fiscal year]. No officer shall serve past the start of the next term unless elected to serve in that term. A person who has served for more than twelve (12) months of a full term shall be deemed to have served a full term in such office.

Officers shall assume their duties on _____ [exact date, recommended to coincide with fiscal year]. No officer shall serve past the start of the next term unless elected to serve in that term. A person who has served in an office for more than twelve (12) months of a full term shall be deemed to have served a full term in such office.
