Any PTA that has 100% of its full-time credentialed teachers as members and submits an application form to the First District office by February 1, 2021, are entered into a drawing to receive free registrations for the 2021 California State PTA Convention in Sacramento.

Senior Membership Incentive Award

All councils that are in good standing* and have met the One More Member for each unit challenge by April 1st will be eligible to win one of five (5) \$500 Membership Incentive Awards to give to a graduating senior of the council's choice.

Senior Membership Incentive Award Details

- Student must be a PTA member.
- Entry is automatic and will be based on the council's in Good Standing status and membership totals remitted to the office, or on TOTEM, as of **10:00 am on Thursday, April 1, 2021.**
- If the number of eligible schools exceeds our budget of \$2,500, we will use a random drawing to select the winners.
- Councils that will be receiving the Membership Incentive Award will be announced at our April 26th Awards meeting and notified by email the same day. Councils that receive the award will then provide First District with the name of the student that is to receive the award along with a description of the criteria used to determine the recipient. First District will need ten (10) days from receiving the student's name to writing the check, so please plan accordingly.

** To be in good standing with First District PTA, a council and its units must:*

- Adhere to the Purposes and basic policies of the PTA
- Have a minimum of fifteen (15) members, including three officers: President, secretary, and treasurer
- Submit per capita dues and insurance premiums by California State PTA due dates
- File all required state and federal tax returns, other government forms, and the Attorney General's Registry of Charitable Trusts report (RRF-1). In addition, uploads tax documents into MyPTEZ Document Management
- Have bylaws reviewed yearly and approved every five years according to the procedures of California State PTA
- Submits Workers Compensation Annual Payroll Report by district due date
- Submits a roster of officers for units and council in MyPTEZ by district due date
- Council president or representative attends monthly First District PTA Board and Association meetings
- Council president submits quarterly written president reports
- Submits council and unit Annual Historian Reports by district due date
- Council is active on TOTEM
